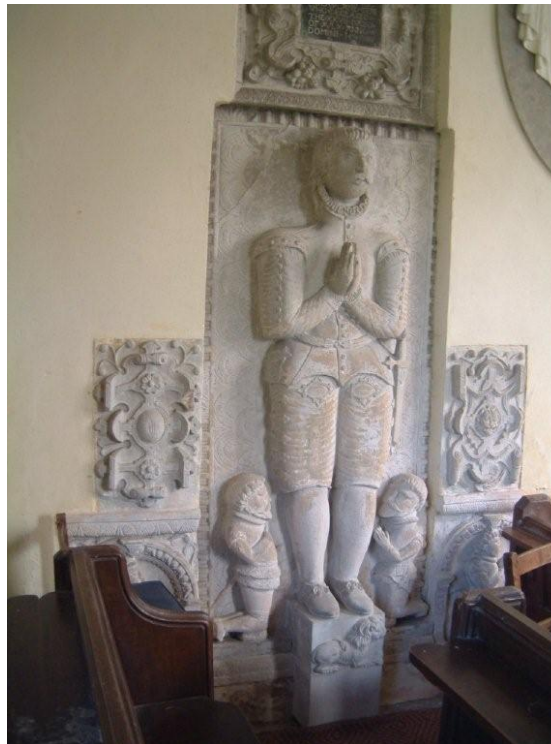
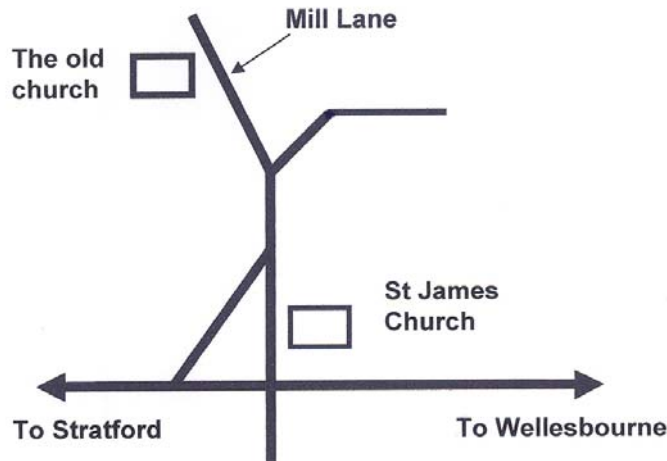

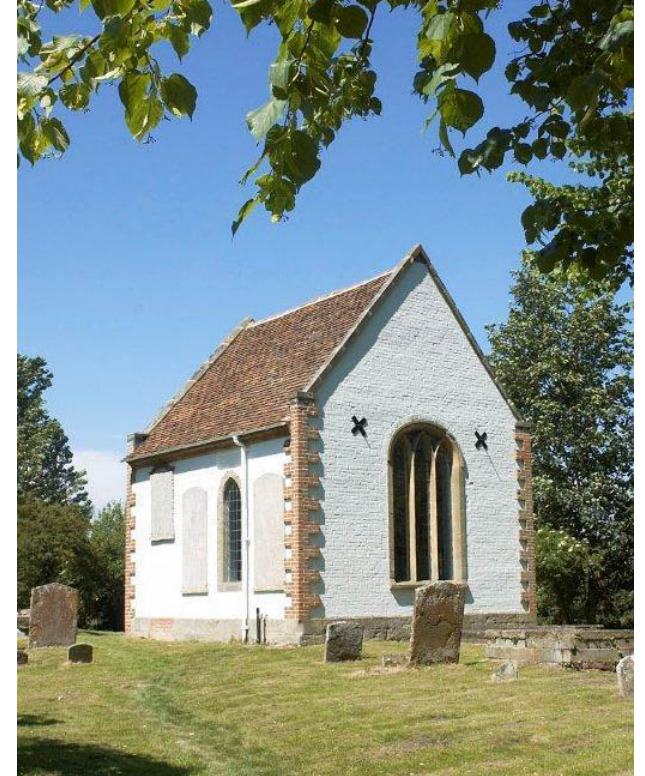

History

The Old Church in Alveston is an important part of the heritage of Alveston and Stratford upon Avon and is a Grade II listed building. Its origins date back to the 10th Century and it contains a tympanum which also dates back to Saxon times. It was the parish church until the present church in Church Lane was completed in 1839.*

The Project

The Friends of the Old Church, Alveston is a registered charity which has the objective of restoring, repairing, maintaining and improving the Old Church of St James, Mill Lane, which includes the churchyard and the monuments, ornaments and chattels of the church.

Membership

Membership of the charity is available to residents of the ecclesiastical parish of Alveston (subject to having been listed on the District Council's electoral roll for at least six months) and corporate bodies whose business is based in the ecclesiastical parish. Membership is currently free and a membership application form is available on request from the Secretary and Treasurer (details on Gift Aid form).

Programme

Funds generated through donations, grants and fund raising activities have enabled a substantial proportion of the restoration work to be undertaken. Work is still continuing and funds are required to complete the works and maintain the Old Church thereafter. Any villagers, parishioners or friends wishing to make a donation are invited to complete the Gift Aid Declaration in this leaflet. Other fund raising activities will continue to be held.
